### INFORMATION ON THE APPLICANT AND THE PARTNERS

#### Applicant:

Danish Forest and Nature Agency

The Danish Forest and Nature Agency is an agency within the Danish Ministry of Environment. The Danish Forest and Nature Agency is responsible for the administration of national policies and legislation concerning protection, management and restoration of nature, open-air activities, hunting and forestry. The responsibilities are among others covering the implementation of the EEC Birds and Habitats Directives and other international nature conservation conventions and agreements, which Denmark has ratified. The agency is managing the State forest areas and other publicly owned nature areas in total around 185.000 ha. It consists of the central administration offices and 25 State forest districts. Management of the project on the Restoration of Dry Grasslands in Denmark is placed at Fussingø State Forest District. It will co-ordinate project implementation and monitor project progress.

Partner 1, 2, and 3: Viborg County, Aarhus County and Fyn County:

The counties in Denmark are independent democratically constituted units. The main tasks for the counties are health care (hospitals, medicine...), education (high schools, adult education), social problems (special institutions), roads, environment including nature conservation and physical planning.

The counties are the regional bodies responsible for the protection of nature and the environment. Planning of land use, protection, monitoring and management of the natural environment in all of these fields, the counties administer under acts passed by the Danish Parliament. The most important acts are the Planning Act, the Environmental Protection Act and the Nature Protection Act.

The counties are responsible for the management of large nature areas in private ownership protected by conservation orders, for mapping and monitoring biological conditions of the nature, designating areas requiring special protection and identifying areas suitable for conservation, and to implement measures for the protection, use and management of areas of outstanding nature value.

The implementation of the agri-environmental scheme in Denmark at present imply only little possibility to link to the conservation work in this project. Support from the agri-environment scheme is prioritised in the areas designated as "special sensitive agricultural areas" (SSA-areas).

Elements of the agri-environmental scheme give some private livestock owners an incen-



tive to participate in grazing projects as a subsidy for the areas grazed. None of the actions specified in this project are receiving funding from the agri-environmental scheme. This LIFE project will provide the basis for using grazing as a management method in the pSCI (fencing material, shelter, water, power) and in some special cases the agri-environmental scheme will increase the number of stock owners interested in participating by providing animals for grazing.

However, new opportunities in relation to the agri-environmental scheme may arise, as a process to revise the agri-environmental scheme in Denmark has begun.
